IMPLEMENTATION OF SUMMER SEMESTER FOR, UG & PG PROGRAMS AY-2025-26


Subject: - Revised Guidelines for Summer Semester

The Summer Semester from AY 2025-26 onwards shall commence in accordance with the revised summer semester guidelines as approved by the Academic Council in its 57th meeting held on 12.12.2025, vide agenda items no. 57.15. The detailed revised guidelines for summer semester are as under:

1.	Students awarded F(fail)/D(detained)/W(withdrawal)-grade in a course will be eligible to register in the course in summer semester.
2.	A Students can register courses in summer semester for maximum of 12 credits. However, if a student's programme curriculum's provision like Summer Training/Industrial Training or similar requirement overlaps with the duration of summer semester, then such a student cannot register in summer semester.
3.	A student is allowed to register in DCC/BSC/ESC/Core/compulsory course (s) only (codes have their usual meaning as per scheme).
4.	The tenure of Summer Semester will be 45-days.
5.	A course will be offered in summer semester only if minimum 20 or 20% of the sanctioned intake students, whichever is less, are registered in the course. All classes will be held in physical mode.
6.	A student will be allowed to appear in the end semester examination of summer semester for the course(s) registered, only if he/she fulfils the attendance criterion for appearing in examination as per regulation R.1(B).22.
7.	A student registering for a course in summer semester will have to pay fee (for each course separately) as per university norms.
8.	Power to remove difficulty: if any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these guidelines, the Vice Chancellor may make such provisions as appeared to be necessary for removing the difficulty.

* These guidelines shall be applicable to all students of UG & PG programs registering for summer semester irrespective of their batch of admission.


