## Notice

1) Applications are invited for B.Tech Final Year students for M.S Program in (i) Data Science and Artificial Intelligence and, (ii) Cyber Security, in collaboration with Houston University. The Houston University mandates 30 credit hours for their MS program in **Data Science and Artificial Intelligence and Cyber Security**. Under 4 + 1 B.Tech-MS collaboration program a total of 9 credits can be read at DTU before physically the student lands on the UH campus. To avail the admission from AY 2026-27, these 3 courses totalling 9 credits (3 credits each) are to be read in the current semester, where all the desirous students need to register at DTU, and have to secure B+ grade.

2) Simultaneously, the students need to apply on UH portal <https://www.applyweb.com/uhouston/index.ftl> for seeking admission under the collaborative program, which on priority will be decided by the Graduate School Office at UH. Upon, obtaining a green signal, the Graduate School Office shall support the students in collaborative program for obtaining US Visa for study as per the following schedule (where he/she will be charged **In-state fee of US \$ 5800** for full semesters each (Fall and Spring) and US \$ 2300 for summer semester.

3) All the admitted students to UH will have an advisor from UH for the courses they read at DTU, and for the research problem they are assigned to enable them work substantially while they study in the current semester at DTU. Later, they may continue with the same problem in fall and spring semesters of AY 2026-27 at UH and finally submit their thesis work in summer semester.

4) Our distinguished alumnus of 1967, Dr. Durga Das Agrawal Ji has pledged to offer **10 scholarships** to cover to/fro air fare, tuition fee for fall, spring, and summer semesters. Hence, the recipients of such scholarship shall have to only for accommodation, food, and their upkeep. **Ten** such best students under this collaborative program will be identified by UH to avail this opportunity.

5) Further, since all the students admitted under this collaborative program are availing In-state tuition fee, they are also entitled for a fellowship of US \$ 1000 (US \$ 500 each for fall and spring semesters) by UH, which will be credited during the respective semesters.
